RESEARCH INTERESTS

My scientific area and specialization are related to **Eastern-Orthodox Ecclesiastical Literature**, a field of studies that methodologically depends on and also presupposes special training and expertise in indexing, entry-listing, and recording of specific notions and terms, constituting the linguistic and conceptual corpus of Patristic texts and Orthodox Christianity. The diversity of themes and methodological approach manifested in my publications (books, treatises, papers etc.) is a result of my systematic work on indexing of theological concepts and notions, either because of personal original research or through the use of the Thesaurus and other relevant or independent indices and sources.

My PhD Thesis examines the pedagogical elements in the Great Canon by Saint Andrew of Crete and presupposed indexing of pedagogical concepts. My treatise titled 'The Mnemonics of the Holy Preaching according to the teaching of St. Chrysostom' was grounded on the use of already indexed terms, concepts and personal research of such concepts in Chrysostomus' works. The critical edition of Saint Neophytos' the Recluse and his Typikon (=Testamentary Rule) manifests my skills in manuscripts' critical edition, which constitutes a strong indication for my adeptness in indexing, analyzing, and reconstructing the original material of Theological Studies.
